May: Everybody attending our April meeting will be provided with a copy of the full programme for the Rebus AGM, scheduled to be held over the weekend from Friday 3rd May to Sunday 5th May. As hosts, all members are welcome to join in the activities planned including the following tours:

Friday 3rd May

Port of Tauranga Tour: If you missed the last tour of the Port of Tauranga this is your opportunity to join us for a very informative tour of the entire Port, on Friday 3rd May starting at 3pm. The Port Company will provide a senior official to act as host. The trip lasts 90 minutes where we will be driven along the port on the Mt Maunganui side and see massive machinery handling a range of forestry products and other cargoes being loaded, as well as bulk raw materials being discharged. We will then travel to the Sulphur Point container terminal and again be very near to these operations as well. Photo ID is required, passengers must be independently mobile and are not allowed to leave the bus. Photos may be taken through the window. Cost: \$20 pp. Don't miss out - it's worth a repeat visit.

Saturday 4th May

Tauranga bus tour visiting local artisan, Kevin McCardell, an extremely accomplished wood sculptor. There will be a morning tea stop (own cost) followed by a visit to one of New Zealand's oldest heritage sites "The Elms". Tour will take approximately 3 hrs at a cost of \$40.00 pp (which includes admission to both venues).

Classic Flyers Museum: Tour starts at 10am from Museum shop guided by Past Co-President Doug Guthrie. Tour cost \$7.50 pp. Add in breakfast or morning tea or early lunch (whatever!) at your own cost.
