Car Park Monitoring Update

As many of you have noticed, our new parking signage has been installed and has already sparked a bit of conversation. We're now able to confirm the next steps in the rollout of our car park monitoring system.

Monitoring will officially begin on Monday, 8th September.

From **8th to 15th September**, the system will be in a **grace period**, during which **warnings** will be issued for any parking violations. After this period, **enforcement and infringements** will commence.

If you need any help scanning the QR code or registering your vehicle, our team is here to assist you. QR codes will be at the entrances, Bar, and Restaurant. If using the QR code is problematic, you're welcome to visit reception, during office hours, where we can register your number directly and have it permanently loaded into the system by Wilson Parking.

Please note:

Parking will only be monitored between **6:00 AM and 5:30 PM**. Outside of these hours, there is no need to scan in, and no enforcement will take place.

We kindly ask that all members respect that the car park is intended for those actively using the club's facilities. We've had some requests to leave vehicles here while heading off elsewhere for the day—unfortunately, that defeats the purpose of this initiative. Our aim is to keep parking accessible for members and guests using the club.
